

Communications Update

Mrs. Compagno distributed and reviewed an updated communication timeline for the November 8 bond referendum.

The group discussed the best ways to reach out to groups such as the Lions Club, the Historical Society, Lymes' Youth Service Bureau, etc., to spread the word on the upcoming referendum.

Mr. Neviaser reviewed the PowerPoint presentation that he intends to show at the public meetings scheduled for October 12, 13 and 26. The committee wordsmithed the presentation offering suggestions for improvement.

The committee discussed whether it was necessary to hold a tour of the buildings at the October 12 and October 26 presentations which take place at Lyme School and Mile Creek School. There was consensus that it should be done after the presentation for those that are interested. The group also discussed the importance of showing the public the current ventilation systems (unit ventilators) and security issues to be addressed at the main entranceways.
