No summer work

Weekly homework time commitment:

- Biweekly lab experiments and reports.
- Chapter problems and reading should take approximately 3-5 hours per week.

AP PHYSICS 1:

Summer work includes:

- 3 hours of applied right angle trigonometry homework with a test the first week of school.

Weekly homework time commitment:

- Remaining chapters approximately one per week.
- Biweekly lab experiments and reports .
- Chapter problems and reading should take approximately 3-5 hours per week.

AP PHYSICS 2:

Summer work includes:

- Three hours of applied right angle trigonometry homework with a test the first week of school.

Weekly homework time commitment:

- Remaining chapters approximately one per week.
- Biweekly lab experiments and reports.
- Chapter problems and reading should take approximately 3-5 hours per week.

AP PSYCHOLOGY:

Summer work includes:

- Materials and course work for Unit 1.

Weekly homework time commitment:

- Reading and homework each day - average of 30-60 minutes.
- Review vocabulary and concepts.

AP US HISTORY:

Summer work includes:

- One supplemental novel and essay.
- Read chapters 1-3 of textbook and create notecards.

Weekly homework time commitment:

- Read 1-2 chapters per week, create notecards.
- Expectation 35-45minutes per week night of homework (mostly reading).
- Essays and tests: one every 3-4 weeks.

AP FRENCH AND SPANISH:

Summer work includes a journal of at least 7 entries that reflect:

- Three current articles in Spanish/French - read, explained, and reflected.
- One full length movie - description of plot, characters and impressions.
- Three open-ended entries.

Weekly homework time commitment between 30-60 minutes including:

- Reading articles, short stories, answering questions.
- Grammar activities.
- AP manual work.

Monthly Expectations:

- Long term goals such as 1-2 compositions (5-paragraph essays) and/or oral presentations.

ECE CONVERSATIONAL & CULTURAL TOPICS IN SPANISH:

No summer work.

Weekly homework time commitment:

Between 30-60 minutes of work including:

- Reading articles, viewing newscasts and answering questions.
- Grammar activities.
- Preparing presentations or compositions.

Summer work includes:

- Create one drawing or painting in a similar style.

Weekly homework time commitment:

- Four hours per week of outside work on portfolio.

AP STUDIO ART - 3D DESIGN:

Summer work includes:

- Research the work of two or three artists to organize influences for concentration.
- Create 6-12 concept sketches for possible sculptures, keep in mind media/materials.

UCONN ECE DRAWING:

No Summer Work

Weekly homework time commitment:

- 30-60 minutes per week creating copies of old master drawings.
- All portfolio work done in class.

AP CALCULUS:

Summer work includes:

- Packet of problems covering Pre-Calculus review materials, due the first day of class.

Weekly homework time commitment:

- Daily homework assignments approximately 45-60 minutes.
- AP free response problems to complete (2 hours).

AP STATISTICS:

Summer work includes:

- Reading chapter 1 and completing problems in text, 1-2 hours to complete.

Weekly homework time commitment:

- Daily homework assignments 20-60 minutes.
- Review vocabulary and concepts.

AP ENGLISH:

Summer work includes:

- Read *The Grapes of Wrath* and selections from *The Bible*.
- Make 100 notecards with mythological and Biblical allusions.

Weekly homework time commitment:

First semester:

- Read 4 longer works (novels, plays, epic poems) 1-3 weeks per work.
- Read 6-8 short stories, 30-60 minutes per story.
- Read various poems.
- Write 3 close reading 2-3 page essays, 2 hours to complete.

Second semester:

- Read 5 novels, 2 weeks per novel
- Write 4 close reading 2-3 page essays, 2 hours each to complete.

One longer research paper (5-7 pages) during the year, 10-12 hours to complete.

ECE MUSIC APPRECIATION:

No summer work

Weekly homework time commitment between 3-4 hours per week including:

- 1-2 chapters per week.
- Quiz or test at the end of chapter.

AP MUSIC THEORY:

No summer work

Weekly homework time commitment between 3-4 hours per week including:

- First 4 chapters completed within first 2 weeks of school.
- Remaining chapters 1-2 per week.
- Sighting and Dictation Lab.
- Analysis and Composition.

ECE MUSIC THEORY:

No summer work.

Weekly homework time commitment 2-3 hours per week including:

- 1-2 chapters per week
- Quiz or test at the end of chapter.

AP BIOLOGY AND ECE BIOLOGY:

Summer work includes:

- Reading a nonfiction book documenting an area of biological research and being prepared to discuss the book the first day of school. Topics are variable and books can be borrowed from local libraries or purchased. Students will make a selection prior to leaving for the summer.

Weekly homework time commitment:

- Reading, notes and problem sets from 1-3 chapters per week.
- Weekly lab experiments and data analysis reports.
- Weekly time commitment outside of school will be 6-10 hours per week.

AP CHEMISTRY:

Summer work includes:

- Problems and reading from Chapters 1-3

Weekly homework time commitment:

- First four chapters completed within first 2 weeks of school.
- Remaining chapters 1-2 per week.
- Weekly lab experiments and reports.
- Chapter problems and reading take approximately 5-7 hours per week.
